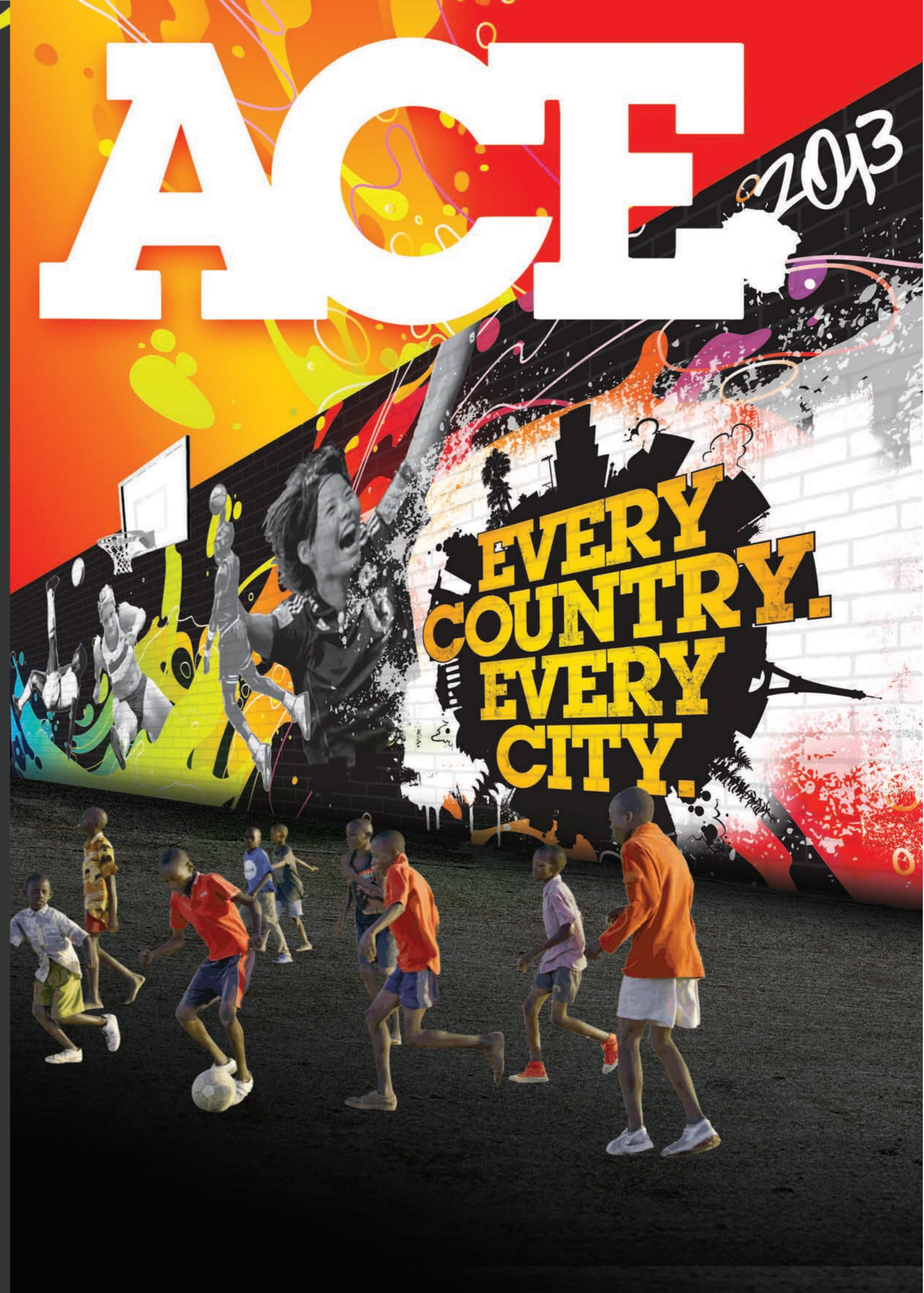

Tracks

Ministry Leaders Track

Do you wish to be more effective in your ministry? Find out the art of self-leadership and being an exemplary 'father' of your ministry. Learn practical applications on how a pastor or ministry leaders can use Sports Ministry to create an impactful movement.

Coaches Track

A coach's job is to help an individual or team get to a level that they cannot get to by themselves. 3-Dimensional Coaching will help you move beyond the "success" of your team towards true "significance" as a coach. It will equip you to win both on the field and in the lives of your athletes by transforming them. Get trained in the crucial components of next level coaching and gain a very strategic vision for yourself as a coach of excellence.

Athletes Track

Ever wondered how you could use your Love for sports to influence your team for Christ? Feeling purposeless as you train with your team week in and week out? Sense that you are a little ineffective in sharing your testimony to your teammates? If you have asked one of these questions, this track is for you! Come and meet other like-minded athletes and discover how God can use you to be the light and the salt of your team!

Strategic Programme (SP) Sessions

Church Sports (CS) (Speaker: Cassie Casten)

This Strategic Programme will explain WHY a church should use Sports Ministry as a tool for discipleship and evangelism. It also explains HOW to use Sports Ministry and WHAT a local church do to get a Sports Ministry started.

Serving the People of Sport (SPS) (Speaker: Reon Tay)

SPS's vision is to see ongoing ministries of serving the people of sport among all peoples of the world and that heaven will be populated with Christian sportspeople from across the globe. Find out how you can serve the sportsperson with unconditional love, helping them to grow to whole life maturity in Christ.

Major Sports Events (MSE) (Speaker: Yuen Chee Onn)

Sport is the universal language of our time. Increasingly, churches and agencies have been seeing the potential of sporting events as a bridge for ministry to the community. This session explains what MSE partnership is and provides you with ministry examples of how your church can impact the community through MSE outreach activities leading to an effective Sports Ministry.

Community, Youth, Children and Sport (CYCAS) (Speaker: Ruth Tan)

CYCAS is about a vision for children and young people of our world. Learn how companies, churches, schools, community groups, sports organizations and local government can all work together to serve the community through sports and value-based programmes. Sports and games, values, compassion, creativity, leadership, involvement and action are all key components of CYCAS.

Electives I

1) Coaching Values Through Sports

Speaker: *Philip Devadas*

Sports can be a learning opportunity to help a young person grow into the person God wants them to be. The coach becomes an important mentor, not only for their sport but also their lives. Get a practical understanding of how it works and what skills are needed to do it well.

2) Mindset of People Serving in Sports Ministry

Speaker: *Ivin Vikesh*

Discover how we can help the sportsperson see sport and faith as integral parts of their lives. Learn how we can walk with the people of sport in loving, nurturing and mentoring relationships, releasing the people of sport into God's authentic call on their lives.

3) Building a Church Sports Team: The AMC Experience

Speaker: *Rayson Seow*

Listen to how GOD transformed a Sunday afternoon "kickabout" to a ministry in His mission field as Rayson shares the journey of Aldersgate Methodist Church (AMC) whom God used to reach out and evangelise to their nearby schools and neighbourhood.

Electives II

1) Community Sports Outreach:

The Church as Transformation Agent of Society

Speaker: *Cassie Casten*

This session will motivate church leaders and give practical advice on how the church could honour its missional, relational and incarnational responsibilities to bring about an effective transformation movement in society.

2) Sports Camps & Leagues

Speaker: *Reon Tay*

Discover how to incorporate spiritual and leadership training into camps and leagues through biblical curriculums that help athletes come to know Christ and continue to grow in Him.

3) Sports Missions

Speaker: *Loh Ngiap Tai*

Learn from a simple model of how you can build your own church sports missions teams to share the gospel in other countries. Most importantly, discover how to disciple young people within these mission teams to continue to live a life for Christ way after the trips have ended!
